







A treat for your taste buds









There is also a fine dining restaurant with banqueting facilities and a Kids' Zone.

An ideal venue for annual festivals, Dilli Haat, Janakpuri has hosted the annual Mango Festival and Magic Festival.











Some special features of the Haat are - A huge dormitory for 80 persons, 5 public toilets with energy efficient fittings and light fixtures, 24 x 7 power back up, a sewage treatment plant, water treatment plant, rain water harvesting and 3 garbage dumping spaces have also been constructed to keep the Haat clean and eco-friendly.







3 buses can be parked at the surface area and almost 55 cars and 120 two wheelers can be parked in the basement parking area.


