A MESMERIZING EXPERIENCE

Panchtatva - The five elements is a tribute to the indomitable personality of Guru Teg Bahadur on his memorial situated at the entry to Delhi on NH1. Initiated by the Government of Delhi this grand monument spread across 11.87 acres emphasizes the role of Guru Teg Bahadur as an inseparable part of the city's history.

In the landscaped tranquil background, the 24 meter high central obelisk with petals at the base represents the Guru & his strength. The C arches denote his three followers and the monoliths represent the 10 Sikh Gurus with their sayings inscribed on them. The concept of Panchtatva, a connect drawn from Guru Saheb's popular reference of '**Hind Ki Chadar**', offers '**Kudrat Ki Chadar**' as a tribute along with an introduction to his life and sacrifice scripted by the celebrated scribe Dr. Maheep Singh. The spectacle unfolds on a musical

interpretation of the Void, Fire, Air, Water & Earth especially composed by **Ustad Amjad Ali Khan**. **Daler Mehndi** has sung the opening bars, **Om Puri** and **Kabir Bedi** have voiced for it in Hindi and English respectively. The mythological bird Phoenix or the Garuda is a leitmotif transition in the show from one element to the next owing to the popular belief in its power of resurrecting itself from the five elements.

The music is contemporary and through it the spectacular visuals come alive making it an experiential delight. With intelligent lighting, architectural mapping based projection, and a surround sound of 5.1, the show is a mesmerizing experience for spectators.
